\$200 Finisher Cash Incentive

Starting in 2010 all athletes who finish the Bigfoot Full Iron Triathlon will receive \$200.

Athletes finishing the Bigfoot Half Iron Triathlon will receive \$100.

Cash will be presented to the athletes at the awards ceremonies the following day to be held in Vancouver.

The organizers have kept the entry fees at the same base rate of \$395.00 for the full iron and \$245.00 for the half iron. The full iron entry includes a polar fleece vest, technical garment and finish medal along with the opportunity to win a medal in their respective age categories. The pre and post event meals are also included while the half iron event entry includes all of the above less the polar fleece vest.

The Finisher Cash Incentive is an initiative to reward the athletes for their months of long training and dedication to the sport.

Athletes may elect to donate their incentive to a charity of their choice however the funds will be credited to the athletes name only. The organizers will not publish the names or give recognition to those that donate funds to a charity.

Athletes must complete the event in under 17 hours to qualify for the incentive.

Athletes who are unable to finish the event may defer their Finisher Cash Incentive to a following years event. Returning athletes will receive a \$100 discount for the full iron and a \$50 discount for the half iron.

Past competitors of the Bigfoot Triathlon events receive a discount of \$100 for the full iron and \$50 for the half iron.
